2020 GUIDELINES FOR SPRING CLEAN UP CURBSIDE May 16, 2020 Items must be out by 7:00 a.m. Rossville Town Residents Only

The following items are allowed for pick up:

- Large appliances: stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, water heaters, water softeners, microwaves. For freezers and refrigerators, the compressors must be removed.
- Large furniture: couches, chairs, tables, mattresses, bed frames, dressers, tables, lamps, end tables, etc.
- Any items such as carpet and padding must be cut in pieces under 6 feet, tied, and or bind.
- No loose items thrown at the curb. Any loose items must be bagged, bind, or tied for easy handling. If not contained properly, the loose items will be left.
- We will take any bagged trash, paper, cans, small misc. items considered household junk.

The following items are not allowed for Spring Clean Up:

- Construction material from a business, building or home: shingles, wood panels, doors, windows, siding, bricks, cement, concrete, drywall, any type of remodeling material.
- Rocks, grass, dirt, tree branches, stumps and trunks, leaves, bushes, and any type of yard waste.
- Wet paint, oil, gas, medical waste, whole tires, auto parts (bumpers, seats, fenders, etc.)
- No messy liquids of any type that could be considered hazardous.
- No burn barrels or their ashes will be taken.
- No car batteries or whole tires (unless cut up into 4 pieces)
- **NO ELECTRONICS:** Air Conditioners, TV's, computers and their accessories, stereos, etc. These items can be taken to Oscar Winski in Lafayette, or any Best Buy, or Office Depot stores.
