1. The meeting was called to order by Freddie Rodkey. Minutes from the July 21, 2020 meeting were approved as presented.
2. Treasurer's Report:

Old Business:

4. There was discussion of an estimate from Skiles Electric to complete electrical upgrades for the Summer's End Festival. This was tabled until next month to give Freddie Rodkey time to collect more information about the upgrades.

will contact the Health Department to see what requirements RBA would need to have in place.
