May 9, 2023

This is a report of the regular meeting of the Rossville Town Council on Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at 6:30 p.m. at the Rossville Town Hall.

On call of the roll: David Severt, Jack Fingerle, and William Croto.

Also present were Chad Colby, Ed Underwood, Chester Bankes, and Deb and Steve Bowman.

David Severt called the meeting to order and minutes from the previous meeting was approved as presented.

Ed Underwood gave a monthly service call report. The department SOPs need to be updated. He wants to contact Lexipol to get an estimate for this service. Council stated he could proceed with obtaining an estimate. There may be an additional part time deputy joining the force. There were complaints received from the audience concerning speeding on N. Delphi Rd. There was a suggestion of possibly installing rumble strips to the roadway. Chad Colby will get an estimate.

Chad Colby stated bids are to be received at the next Council meeting for the demolition of the Town Park water tower. He is hoping to resume sewer cleaning this summer. He has Donohue and Associates checking to see if it is feasible cost wise to install a drying bed for sludge. S. Gaddis St. reconstruction will be starting when school is out for the summer. Duke Energy is requesting the area where a power pole is to be relocated due to the construction. BF & S presented a supplemental agreement to have the survey completed at a cost of no more than \$4500.00. Bill Croto made a motion to approve the agreement, seconded by Jack Fingerle, and passed by Council. There was discussion of applying for another Community Crossing Matching Grant to resurface N. Delphi Rd, a section of W. South St past Sherlock St., and N. East St. The renovation project at the Agrico building has begun.

Robert Shaffer discussed the current trash contract.

Approval was given to Pat McIIrath to proceed with the process of an additional appropriation of the funds from the sale of both golf carts to assist with the repairs to the white utility truck.

Voucher Register and Allowance Dockets were presented to Council for review and approval.

There was continued discussion of updates to the employee handbook.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, June 13, 2023 at 6:30 p.m. at the Rossville Town Hall.
