June 11, 2024

This is a report of the regular meeting of the Rossville Town Council on Tuesday, June 11, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at the Rossville Town Hall.

On call of the roll: Stan Cox, Sally McGill, and Ben Kellogg.

Also present were Robert Shaffer, Chad Colby, Deb & Steve Bowman, Ed Underwood, Shawn Morris, Julie Gable, Brett Woodard, and Liz Stitzel.

Stan Cox called the meeting to order. Sally McGill made a motion to accept last month's minutes. Ben Kellogg seconded. Motion was approved by council.

Town Marshal Ed Underwood discussed stolen gravel with the council, stating he is in the process of collecting money from the subject. Marshall Underwood introduced the name of new deputy, Spencer Kingery. Marshall Underwood informed the council that he applied for a grant for \$136k for handheld and car radios. Marshall Underwood asked the council for 20 additional patrol hours/week during Summer break. McGill made a motion to accept the hours, Kellogg seconded. Marshall Underwood asked the council for permission to utilize the park pavilion for training in October, McGill made a motion to accept the proposal, Kellogg seconded.

Liz Stitzel, from APC, proposed LUPARO 0624385, explaining new flood plain amendments and additions. Council tabled adoption of plan to be voted on next meeting. Council asked town lawyer, Bob Shaffer, to review and advise council.

Chad Colby discussed the IDEM inspection with council, Rieth-Riley pay request of \$17,000 for finalization of the East North St project, which McGill made motion to settle and Kellogg seconded, shared staffing concerns, and discussed hanging basket bracket cost.

Bob Shaffer agreed to meet with council and Township Trustees for a special meeting on 06/18/2024 to discuss little league field.

Julie Gable discussed with council that 2 trailers need to be removed from the town streets that have been unhitched and unplated for more than a year.
